Dear Member(s) of Trinity,

This letter is just to inform and clarify the **worship time change** beginning May 26th. To clarify why there will be a time change, Pastor Teri's other churches in Colby and Athens routinely change worship times every year, 9:00 and 10:30. When Pastor took on Trinity as her third church, it was understood that we would have to find a time that would not affect her other churches. While Colby's worship has been at 9 and Athens' at 10:30, we were able to have ours at 8:00 so that she could still make the 9:00 service in Colby. On Memorial Day weekend they will be switching their times so that Athens will be at 9 and Colby will be at 10:30. We knew we would have to accommodate that schedule which is why we have been discussing options. Two times were most popular in discussion - 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. - so a vote was recently taken to determine which time would fit the majority. Some things just aren't that simple. The final vote was VERY close so Pastor Teri suggested a compromise of having worship at 7:30 the first two Sundays of the month and 6:00 the third and fourth Sundays. The fifth Sunday will be 6:00 as well unless something special is planned. So, that being said, the following is the schedule for worship beginning May 26th. Please make note of the times which will also be posted in the monthly Tidings.

May 26th - 7:30 a.m. August 4th - 7:30 a.m.

June 2nd - 7:30 a.m. August 11th - 7:30 a.m.

June 9th - 7:30 a.m. August 18th - 6:00 p.m.

June 16th - 6:00 p.m. August 25th - 6:00 p.m.

June 23rd - 6:00 p.m. September 1st - 7:30 a.m.

June 30th - 6:00 p.m. September 8th - 7:30 a.m.

July 7th - 7:30 a.m. September 15th - 6:00 p.m.

July 14th - 7:30 a.m. September 22nd - 6:00 p.m.

July 21st - 6:00 p.m. September 29th - 6:00 p.m.

July 28th - 6:00 p.m.

Attendance may become a factor in whether or not we keep this varied schedule. The hope, of course, is for people to attend both times as much as possible. If you have any questions, please contact a council member.
